Get To The Point - Five Points Shops Open Amidst Construction ... & Need Your Help

Five Points (the intersect of Glenwood Avenue with Fairview and Whitaker Mill Roads) is a funky Raleigh neighborhood where trendy stores and art galleries intermingle with restaurants and pubs that offer lively menus and libations. It is also the spot where crumbling concrete, brittle storm drains, and old trolley rails turned a DOT repaving job between Five Points and Wade Avenue into a complete rehab ... extending the inconvenience into August.
