On August 20 - 22nd, Raleigh will be revving with excitement as the **Carolina Classics at the Capital** brings the Southeast's largest indoor car show to the Raleigh Convention Center. Up to 800 classic cars and trucks will be parked on or near historic

Fayetteville Street while an additional 80 show cars and up to 100 vendors will be on display in the new Raleigh Convention Center. There is also a KidsZone with inflatable attractions. A complete sellout is expected.

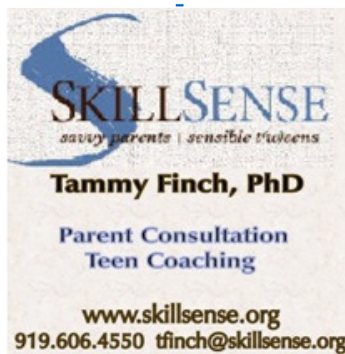

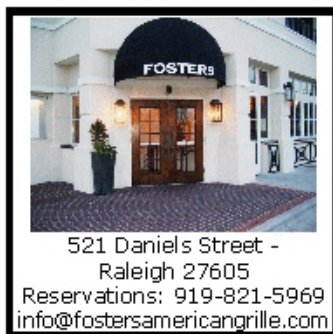
