Featured are 12 premium, handcrafted styles of draught including the hard-hitting Dark Horse Belgian Amber, the smooth Wildflower Witbier, and the pungent Guilford Golden. The pub fare is a mix of traditional and not-so-typical with lots of choices. 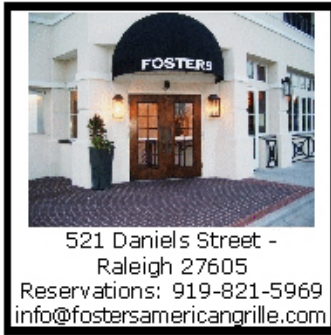

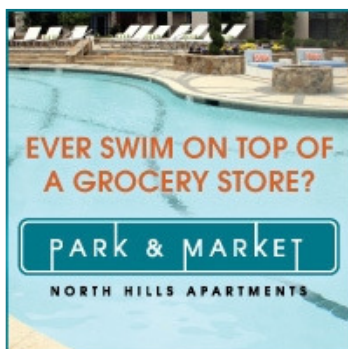

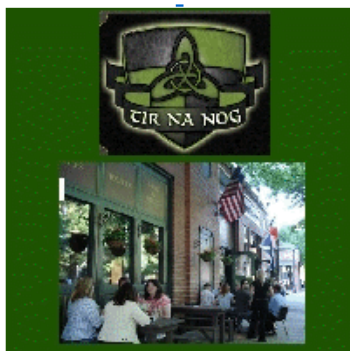
