Gooooaaalll! 2010 World Cup fever is sweeping the nation. Okay, fine, every other nation. But one look at Ronaldo, Donovan, Kaká, or Drogba, and it's easy to see why you should follow soccer - If you don't believe us, check out the June cover of **Vanity Fair**. Hot guys aside, soccer is the most popular sport on Earth and the South Africa World Cup will dominate TV coverage for the next month. The Triangle venues (see below) will be filled with people sporting their team colors and shouting "Olé! Olé! Olé! Olé!"



So what's the big deal about the World Cup? ... Besides thousands of colorful, crazed fans blowing obnoxious buzzing horns non-stop for 90 minutes. Perhaps a Buzz cheat sheet would help. Key facts: The World Cup takes place every four years - 32 countries compete from June 11 - July 11 for the title and \$420 million in prize money;

Brazil has won the World Cup more than any other country with five total victories and a lot of people are betting on them this year, although Spain and Italy are also predicted to do well. Key games: US vs. England (1-1 tie on June 12); Brazil vs. Ivory Coast, June 20; South Africa vs. France, June 22; and Germany vs. Ghana, June 23.
